All motorcycle instructors have heard questions from students such as, "I am nervous about learning to ride. Can I have a private session before I join the class?" or, after completing a class, "I want to have some training on my motorcycle before I ride on the street. Can I have a private session on my bike?"

The robust answer is "Certainly!" You can now provide these students with the additional training they want! The key is to maintain an evaluation structure that is reasonable and defensible. This is why we can provide insured training for you, the instructor.

All instructors who provide small classes or one-on-one training have the need for an evaluation procedure to analyze the student's skills and determine where best to spend their practice time. For your private session you will use the B2R/C2R range cards as an evaluation guide and can move quickly through the evaluation points getting to the areas where your students need help and practice.

Important in Private Sessions: You do not have to complete each exercise to complete the evaluation. For example, if you have students who want to practice with you on their bike, and they had recently completed a course and have their motorcycle license, the evaluation points for the exercises in b1, b2 and b3 can be completed in a few minutes so your students can practice any of the continue2ride exercises! Another example is a true beginner that would like some practice before taking a class with a large group. The instructor may spend two hours covering the skill set in b1 as "pre-training" for the larger class they will be joining.
