

National Motorcycle Training Institute Recognized Instructor Minimum Requirements

An NMT recognized instructor is, at a minimum, one who:

- Has a high school diploma or equivalent
- Has certified in adult CPR and First Aid within the previous two years.
- Is committed to being an educator.

and

- Has previously owned and operated a motorcycle for a minimum of one year and a minimum riding of 1000 miles.
- Is a licensed motorcyclist, and has never had motorcycle license suspended or revoked.

and

- Agrees with and promotes the NMCTI Mission.
- Has begun an NMT instructor preparation course of study,
- Has been evaluated, and approved, by an NMT instructor trainer, for the recognition as an NMT instructor.
- Is an employee or owner of a motorcycle training provider that conducts NMCTI curricula.
